Rules for Field Usage

Welcome to SBCC. We are happy to have you here and excited that today's contest will be conducted on our new "*UBU Speed Series S5-M*" field. Used properly, even under the most severe athletic playing conditions, our new turf system will provide many years of high performance and safety.

However, there are several precautions that need to be taken to insure trouble-free use and turf longevity. It is important that you are aware that the following items are prohibited from the field surface.

- 1) Candy
- 2) Chewing gum
- 3) Sunflower seeds
- 4) Food
- 5) With the exception of water, no liquids of any kind (sodas, sport drinks, coffee, tea, juices, etc). State Law prohibits the use, possession or distribution of alcohol anywhere on campus.
- 6) Equipment that has not been pre-approved by the Athletics Department.
- 7) Use of long spike track shoes, metal cleats and/or any non-plastic/rubber material on sole of shoes
- 8) Tobacco products
- 9) Liquid solvents or corrosive materials of any type, including non-water based paint or other non-water based liquid products
- 10) Golfing or Javelin throwing
- 11) Open flames, cigarettes, fireworks, etc.
- 12) Trucks and auto traffic, including motorcycles, ATV's etc. as well as strollers and bicycles.

We ask for your cooperation in observing the above and require a signature confirming your understanding that failure to comply with these rules may result in the loss of the Facilities Use Permit and/or assessment of fines.
